


- Career advice

Networking Events


- Have a goal and a quick overview of yourself
- Read the event details before going; research who will be there if you can
- Dress professionally, and wear something with pockets
- Bring a friend and use each other!
- Everyone is nervous!
- State your name clearly and use it multiple times

- Look people in the eye, and smile






Networking Events

- Limit yourself to one drink, or drink tonic water
- Eat ahead of the event
- Reward yourself after
- Follow up

What on earth do I say to a faculty member?

- How long have you been at SPEA?
- What classes do you teach?
- What research projects are you working on right now?
- Do you have any restaurant recommendations in Bloomington?
- Do you have any off the wall recommendations for what to do in town?



What not to say...

- I am Alison, I need a job/internship!
- Hi! Is your company/agency hiring?
- Hi, I only came here for a job. Do you know of anyone hiring?
- I don't really know what I want to do. SHARE YOUR VISION, it can always change!
- Listen fully to others and don't interrupt to get your point across!



How to Exit a Conversation


- Very nice talking with you _____. I am going to get another bite to eat. Thank you so much for your time!

Informational Interviews

- Getting your foot in the door and your name recognized
- Come prepared with an agenda and questions
 you're trying to impress this person
- Build the relationship make that person feel seen
- Follow up with a thank you, then send additional follow ups in the coming months

Come prepared with: resume, cover letter, list of desired employers/fields/locations, a 2-3 sentence overview of yourself

We will review potential alumni connections and you will do additional research

Provide your top selections to our office, and we work to make introductions for you

Workshops and Career Panels


- Come prepared with questions

Extracurricular Activities


- Are you building your network of likeminded SPEA students?

Faculty Office Hours


- "But I get everything in class"


