- SPEA-V 506 Statistics: Waived based on completion of Statistical Analysis of Public Administration at SNU.
- SPEA-V 512 OR V538: Waived based on completion of either Theories of Public Policy and Institutions OR Theories of Global Public Administration at SNU.

Requirement II: MPA Concentration (15 credit hours)

Dual MPA students are expected to complete one of O'Neill's MPA concentrations or create a specialized concentration.

A minimum of 30 O'Neill credits must be earned between the core and concentration, and students cannot be waived of concentration requirements.
