

**Dual MPA-MPA at SNU – O’Neill Program Requirements**  
**Requirements for students admitted in summer 2022 and after.**

**MPA Program Requirements: (30 credit hours)**

**Requirement I: MPA Core (15 credit hours)**

The following courses are required:

**Note:** The following courses will be **waived** from the MPA Core based on coursework completed at SNU.

- **SPEA-V 600 Capstone:** Waived based on completion of Master’s thesis at SNU.
- **SPEA-V 506 Statistics:** Waived based on completion of Statistical Analysis of Public Administration at SNU.
- **SPEA-V 512 OR V538:** Waived based on completion of either Theories of Public Policy and Institutions OR Theories of Global Public Administration at SNU.

**Requirement II: MPA Concentration (15 credit hours)**

Dual MPA students are expected to complete one of O’Neill’s MPA concentrations or create a specialized concentration.

**A minimum of 30 O’Neill credits must be earned between the core and concentration, and students cannot be waived of concentration requirements.**
